We seek both broad and specific papers. We want to engage with all our interest groups and membership and to support the active dialogue between members and others in the international law community on topical issues of interest in international law.

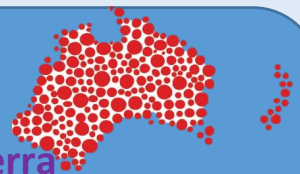
We welcome submissions from early career researchers and PhD students.
